"HE LOVED ME TO THE END..."

- Everybody sins in one way or the other during his lifetime and is impure before God who is holy and righteous.
- Because God loves us and is merciful, He doesn't want anyone to go to hell because of his sins.
- But God is just and therefore doesn't leave our sins unpunished. For this reason God instituted the offering of animal sacrifices to accompany repentance. God used sacrifices as a sign of what was going to happen in the future, just as He did when He redeemed Abraham's son with the ram of redemption, in order to let man understand the necessity of what He

intended to do. Because a person's life is too precious and costly to be redeemed by another person or an animal, God had to redeem us Himself. It was necessary because no person is holy and righteous enough to save himself. God the Greatest, able to do anything He pleases, did this through the Messiah (Christ) Jesus.

 And so the Eternal Word of God became flesh, and Jesus the Messiah was born from a virgin through the miraculous working of the Holy Spirit of God. He lived a glorious life without sin, performed many wonderful miracles and in the fullness of time was crucified at the hands of those who didn't accept Him as the Messiah.
